3. All sheep over 1 year old must be registered in their breed association. Exhibitor will furnish registration certificate if requested by Superintendent.
4. Exhibitors will be limited to two entries in individual classes and one entry in group classes.
5. Date for computing age of sheep is September 1st.

### ALL GOATS MUST HAVE OFFICIAL APPROVED USDA SCRAPIE IDENTIFICATION TO BE PRESENTED BEFORE UNLOADING SUNDAY 2-7 PM

1. All entries must be place by 7 PM on Sunday.
2. No animals shall be removed until Saturday 12:00 midnight. Premium money will be forfeited if livestock is removed before that time.
3. No bucks are allowed on the grounds; horned animals, other than pygmies and angoras, are not allowed. Dehorning paste or evidence thereof is not allowed on animals.
4. All animals will be inspected by Superintendent (or his agent), and his decision for calling a veterinarian or removing an animals will be upheld.
5. Exhibitors will be limited to two entries in an individual class.
6. Date for computing age of animals is show day.
7. Only one entry per Section Per Exhibitor in Wether Sections.
8. A mandatory milk out for all milking does will be at **8:00 pm Sunday** (kids pulled from doe and udder completely milked out).
9. No unruly behavior will be tolerated before, during & after the Fair. Appropriate action will be taken to remedy problem
